Introducción al estudio taxonómico de Anopheles de Colombia - González Obando, Ranulfo 2009-12-09

En los programas de control de vectores, un aspecto de reconocida importancia es la diferenciación de las especies involucradas en la transmisión de enfermedades de importancia en salud pública, ya que de esto depende en gran parte el diseño de la estrategia y la aplicación selectiva de diferentes métodos o alternativas de control. En el caso particular de los vectores de malaria, es relativamente fácil reconocer el género *Anopheles* y sus respectivos subgéneros, pero cuando se trata de la diferenciación específica resulta a veces complejo reconocer los caracteres diagnósticos que las diferencian. En el caso de Colombia, se ha podido registrar cerca de 40 especies por caracteres morfológicos, pero es posible que ese número sea mayor. En general, se reconoce que muchas de las especies neotropicales de *Anopheles* son parte de o constituyen un complejo de especies crípticas, ya que la variabilidad intraespecífica que éstas exhiben, se traslapa en muchos de los caracteres medibles, haciendo difícil su diferenciación. Este libro es un intento por resolver, al menos parcialmente, este problema para las especies que actualmente son conocidas en Colombia. Con base en revisiones de caracteres diagnósticos, estudios de variabilidad en hembras de algunas de las especies y adecuaciones de claves de determinación ya existentes, se presentan claves dicotómicas de diferenciación de especies de *Anopheles*, para larvas, hembras y genitalia de machos. Por otro lado, se ha realizado un esfuerzo por presentar un gran número de ilustraciones con el propósito de facilitar la identificación de los caracteres diagnósticos que se presentan en las claves. Adicionalmente se da la distribución conocida de las especies nombradas en las claves, en los diferentes departamentos y municipios de Colombia y métodos de preservación de adultos, larvas y genitalia de machos. Con el propósito de hacer más útil el uso de este texto se presenta también una clave dicotómica ilustrada para la diferenciación de géneros de larvas y hembras de la familia Culicidae con distribución en Colombia.
