The principles and vision in it need to be imparted to the leaders in order to see spiritual growth in the people so they discover their God-given rights and privileges, understand their place on the team, and are educated, equipped, and empowered to walk their own unique journey with God on this Earth. As that happens, the growth in the people themselves will cause expansion of the Kingdom of God. As spiritual leaders we are responsible for the people God plants in our care (Hebrews 13:17) so it's imperative we do things "decently and in order".
